Problem:

- Lady with a urostomy had been experiencing leaks at 3 o'clock where a crease leads to the midline scar.
- Contacted nurse for advice.

Problem:

Patient history:

- 59 year old male with a tumour down the oesophagus, required a jejunostomy with the implantation of a port.
- Food is semi-liquid, taken naturally and enteral nutrition.

Problem:

• 3 weeks later Mr F is in a lot of pain and has skin damage so the nurse creates a care procedure using saline solution and a Biosorb pad.

Nurse Review:

- 2 days later Mr F is still experiencing a lot of pain and skin damage so the nurse creates a new care procedure using a large hydrocolloid which allows a catheter to go through.
- The nurse creates a barrier with eakin **Cohesive®** paste and a secondary plaster on top.

- After 5 days, there is no more pain and skin around the stoma is improved so the same care procedure is continued.
